Dummy Roping Changes

In response to feedback from our members, we relocated the Beginner and PeeWee Dummy Roping and scheduled it as the first event at our family rodeos. We'd love to hear your thoughts on this change!

Stalls Open Year Round

In March, the Board of Directors voted to keep ten stalls open and available for use year-round. Previously, all stalls were locked and only opened upon request. To streamline access, a lockbox and clear signage has been installed, allowing users to make a \$25 per stall payment based on the honor system. Additionally, active MHSC members can enjoy free access to the stalls as part of their membership benefits.



Facility Improvements

Water Hydrants: Water lines were extended to add three new water hydrants by the horse stalls and one behind the rough stock pens.

Crow's Nest: The crow's nest platform was enclosed to improve visibility for those working inside the crow's nest.

Portable Panels: Sixty portable panels and three panel trailers were purchased to allow for additional stalls to be set up during larger events like the High School Rodeo.

Signs: Signs were placed on the rodeo office identifying the building; along with a thank you sign to the donors.
